OVERVIEW

The **SBIR Boot Camp** is a unique proposal writing initiative offered for the first time in the St. Louis Region to help principal investigators draft a winning proposal in response to the currently open NIH solicitation. **Submission date: March 13 at completion of Boot Camp. (NIH due date: April 5, 2010).**

The **SBIR Boot Camp** is designed for busy PIs who have great research ideas and little time to prepare grant proposals. Working one-on-one with a professional editor / tech writer who "reads behind" you, your team will prepare a final Phase I proposal in just two days, as opposed to the 2-3 weeks normally spent writing this document. *You* take care of the content; your *editor* helps craft a compelling proposal and addresses all formatting issues.
